## From Edinburgh Airport to Musselburgh (Loretto School):

**Taxis:** Edinburgh Airport and Edinburgh Waverley Rail stations have taxi ranks (approx. cost £40 airport/£25 Waverley station, to Loretto). Callout of local Musselburgh taxis is cheaper (£30/£20 approx), subject to availability:

**Buses:** Airport Bus to central Edinburgh/Edinburgh Waverley Bridge (opposite Rail Station) (left luggage facility at station north (Princes Street) side)

Frequency: Every 10 minutes (early services every 20 minutes).

Journey time: 25 minutes (Waverley Bridge).

Fare: Single £3.50, return £6 (reductions for children).
